PERENNIALS

Anise Hyssop (Agastache-Black Adder) — Part/Full Sun. Dark buds open to smoky lilac flowers. Bicolor effect. Long bloom 30"h.

ASTER — Plant in full sun, grows 18"-24" tall, blooms late summer into fall. Varieties include:

- **Puff** — white flowers.
- **Alice Haslam** — dwarf red, 12-15", mid-season bloom.
- **Loke Viking** — deep raspberry colored flowers.
- **Melody** — blue-lavender flowers.

Asiatic Lilly — Full sun. Varieties include:

- **Crimson Pixie** — stunning bold red/burnt orange lilies.
- **Spark** — pink flowers with yellow center.
- **Grand Cru** — bright red petals w/bold red brush stroke in throat.
- **Lollipop** — white petals and rich pink tips.

Astilbe — Shade /part shade (white, pink, violet, red, lavender flowers). Varieties include:

- **Diamant** — pure white flowers, plume like arrangements, blooms July- August.
- **Amerika** — light pink flowers, 30-36" h, blooms June-July.
- **Amethyst** — dark violet pink flowers, blooms July-August.
- **Fanal** — compact, dark blood red plumes, blooms July-August.
- **Purple Candles** — dense lavender-purple spikes.

Balloon Flower — Full sun (blue flowers, bloom mid-late summer).

Candy Tuft — Full sun, white flower.

Cinquefoil Goldstar

Clematis — Full/part sun (flowering vine). Varieties include:

- **Lanugmosa Candida** — height 12', white flowers, blooms June-July and again in September.

Coreopsis — Full sun/part shade. Varieties include:

- **Sweet Dreams** — 18'h x 18"w, white flower bleeding into a dark raspberry center, blooms June-October.
- **Crème Brulee** — bright deep yellow flowers, blooms June-Oct.
- **Zagreb** — bright golden yellow flowers, blooms July-September. Ideal for limited space gardens. 18" spread.
- **Moonbeam** — delicate lemon yellow flowers, blooms June to frost. Compact grower, 15-18" high.

Columbine — Part sun/shade, 24"h x 16"w, blooms spring.

Daylily — Various colors, some varieties bloom all season.

- **Canadian Border Patrol** — (re-bloomer) cream with purple eye zone and green throat, edged lightly with purple.
- **Double Orange** — double orange flowers, blooms mid-season.

SHRUBS

Azalea — *Evergreen and Deciduous varieties available include:*

- **Herbert** — *evergreen, part sun/shade, lavender flower, blooms early May, 2-4' h, spread 3-5', hardy and dependable.*
- **Hino Crimson** — *low growing, compact plant, dark green leaves are small and turn to bronze in winter, part sun/shade, crimson red blooms, blooms early May, 2-3' h x 2-3' w.*
- **Rosebud** — *the opening buds resemble rosebuds, double flowers rosy pink, flowers late may thru June, habit is spreading and compact, 2-3' h x 2-3' w.*
- **Rosey Lights** — *fragrant rose-pink w/red shadings, upright spreading, full sun/part shade, deciduous, 4-5' h x 5-6' w.*
- **Hershey Red** — *large, floral quality double dark red flower, mid-season, full sun, 12-24" h.*
- **Tradition** — *accent plant, shell pink flowers, blooms mid-season, height 12"*
- **Frilly Lemon** — *(deciduous) canary yellow frilled flowers. double blooms, 4'h x 4'w, dense upright habit.*
- **Homebush** — *(deciduous) compact, rounded trusses of bright pink semi-double funnel shaped flowers, late spring, part shade, flowers in May.*
- **Gilbralter** — *(deciduous) orange flower, blooms in May, 6'h x 6'w.*
- **Sun Chariot** — *(deciduous) yellow flower, midseason bloom, height 6'.*
- **Girard Fuschia** — *single, reddish-purple petals with wavy margins, early to mid-season (march to april), 2-4'h x 3-5'w, semi-evergreen, part sun.*
- **Deleware Valley White** — *medium sized, single white blossoms, 2-4'h x 3-5w, part sun, blooms in April.*
- **Hersheys Red** — *bright red, hardy, 3-4 height, blooms in May.*
- **Stewartstonian** — *red flower, red winter foliage, round habit 4-5'height, flowers May-June.*
- **Orchid Lights** — *orchid colored flowers, blooms mid-May, compact plant, 3'h x 3'w, hardy.*

Silver Sword — Vivid red flower, variegated foliage. Height 3-4'. Blooms May-June.

Barberry(Wintergreen) — Full Sun, 6'x8', brightly colored fruit Thorny, evergreen, blooms spring.

Clethra — (deciduous) Compact, white and rose colors. Varieties include:

- **Hummingbird** — compact, height 2.5 - 3.5 ' forms large colonies, white flowers, blooms July-August.
- **Ruby Spice** — deep rose colored, non fading fragrant flowers, height 6-8'.

Fothergilla — Mt. Airy- yellow, orange or red flowers. Red fall color. Height 5-6'.

Holly — Varieties include:

- **Japanese** — densely shrubby, full sun, height 5'-10'x 5'-10'.
- **Robin** — dark green leaves, new growth is maroon, female, produces red berries, height 14' x 8' spread.
- **Chinese (Dwarf)**.

Leatherleaf Mahonia (Oregon Grape) — Mostly shade, 10-12 feet high lemon yellow flowers. Late winter to early spring. Berries turn from Robin egg blue to blue-black.

Itea (little henry) — Deciduous, sun/part shade. Height 2.5' x 3', leaves turn red in fall, White bottlebrush blooms, dwarf, blooms early summer.

Kalmia Latifolia (Mt. Laurel) — Varieties include:

- **Elf** — masses of near white flowers, dwarf, heavy bloomer, height 2.5' x 4-5', part shade, blooms early spring, May-June.
- **Little Linda** — (dwarf) buds are dark red, open to near white, and age to rich pink, blooms May-June, 3'h x 3'w.
- **Sarah** — vivid red buds open to bright pinkish red flowers, rich green glossy leaves and vigorous compact habit, prefers more sun than other varieties, blooms May-June, 3-4' hx 3-4'w.
- **Minuet** — smaller growing variety with large banded flowers, light pink buds open to dark pink flowers with light pink center, blooms May-June, 2'-3' x 2'-3'.
- **Olympic Fire** — dark pink to red buds open to white flowers, then fade to pink, wavy, lustrous glossy thick foliage, dense habit, blooms May-June, 3'-4'h x 3-4'.

Mugo Pine(dwarf) — Very drought tolerant, low dense compact form, height 3-6'.

Nandina Domestica — Sun/part shade. Varieties include:

- **Gulf Stream Heavenly Bamboo** — mostly shade/sun, height 2-8', late summer and fall clusters of red berries, creamy flowers appear.
- **Harbour Dwarf** — height 2-3', forms a graceful mound.

Rhododendrum — Varieties include:

- **P.J.M.** — vivid lavender pink flowers occur in mid-late April, dark green leaves turn reddish purple in winter, 3'-6'x 3'-6', blooms early to midspring.
- **Olga** — clear pink flowers.

Spiraea — (deciduous) Varieties include:

- **Neon Flash** — deep pink, nearly red blooms, stays densely packed and neatly rounded, 3'h x 3'w, full sun, blooms early summer.
- **Anthony Waterer** — blooms summer, low shrubby growth, 3' x 5', wine-red to maroon tinged, new growth in the fall, rose pink, blooms from late spring into summer, sun/part shade.
- **Birchleaf** — 2'x 3', white flowers, blooms May-June, full sun, foliage turns copper, red or purple before it falls, purplish buds.
- **Shirobana** — red buds, white and deep pink blooms, blooms in summer, full sun, 2'x3'.
- **Japanese** — 2'-6' x 2-6', drought tolerant, full sun, blooms spring and summer, magenta red blooms, fall foliage is coppery orange.
- **Goldmound** — small light pink flowers, 3'x 4', blooms early summer full sun/part shade.
- **Little Princess**
